Our courses for school groups follow a specific syllabus and include course materials so that the students benefit from structured learning and we can maintain a high quality of teaching.


VARIED PROGRAMME






LONDON EXPLORER MINI STAY WILLESDEN CENTRE



Brighton is bustling with British students and tourists alike and attracts 8 million visitors a year. It was recently voted Britain's coolest beach resort.






OVINGDEAN BRIGHTON RESIDENTIAL CENTRE

The Neighbourhood

Our Brighton residential campus is in the affluent village of Ovingdean surrounded by the beautiful rolling hills of the South Downs, and is even home to some international celebrities.

The Activities


Language in Action always strives to provide as immersive an English experience as possible with regular excursions to the city so that students can interact with their environment and social activities on campus in the evening.


The Accommodation
