### The Neighbourhood

The Zone 1 location makes it ideal for exploring London by Tube or on foot. Old Street underground station is just a short walk from the accommodation.

The area itself is considered one of the trendiest in London. Shoreditch is home to IT start-ups, artists, coffee shops, and the infamous Cereal Killer Cafe. Students are bound to appreciate the young, fashionable atmosphere of the area.

### The School
